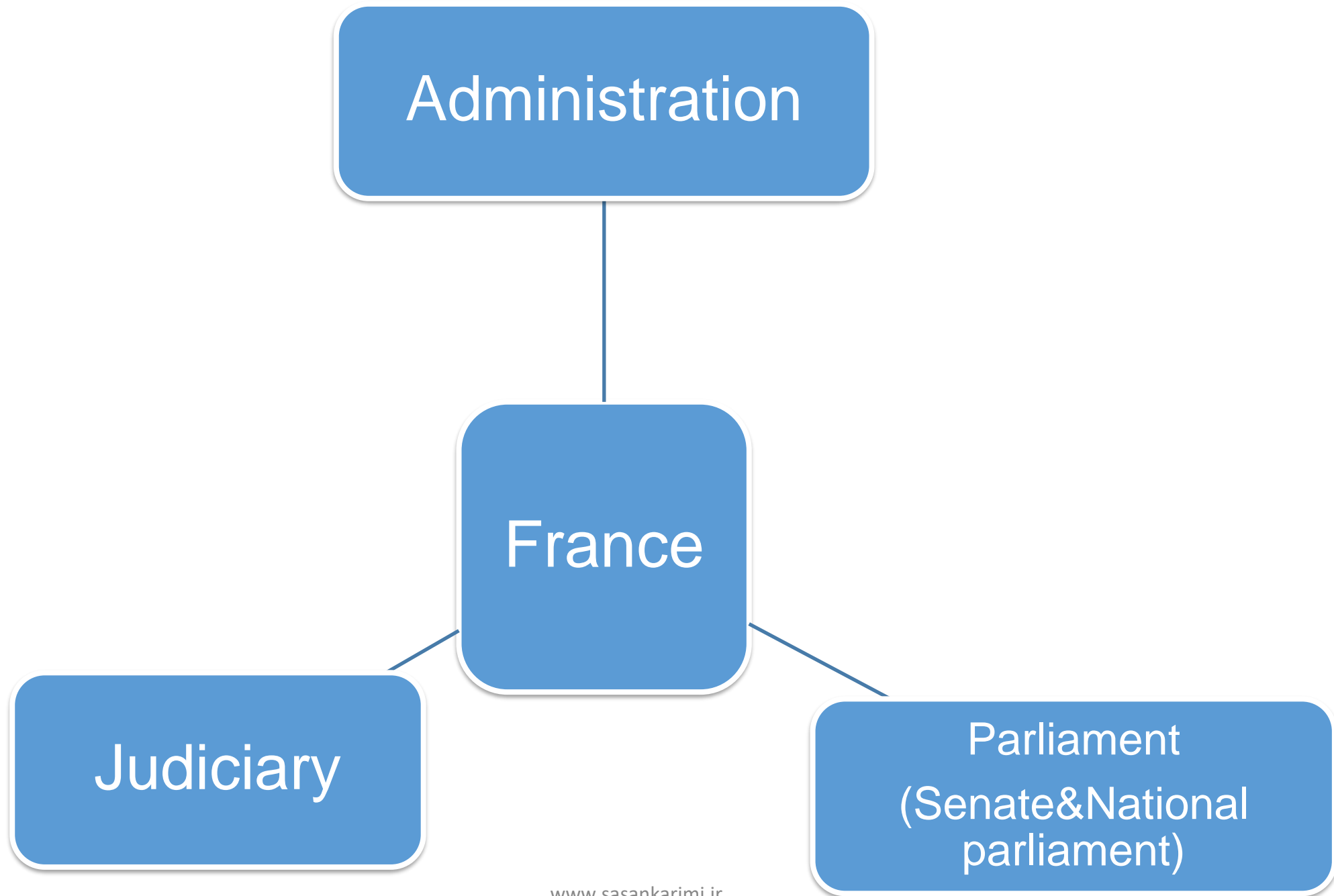

François Mitterrand – Charles de Gaulle foreign policy doctrine

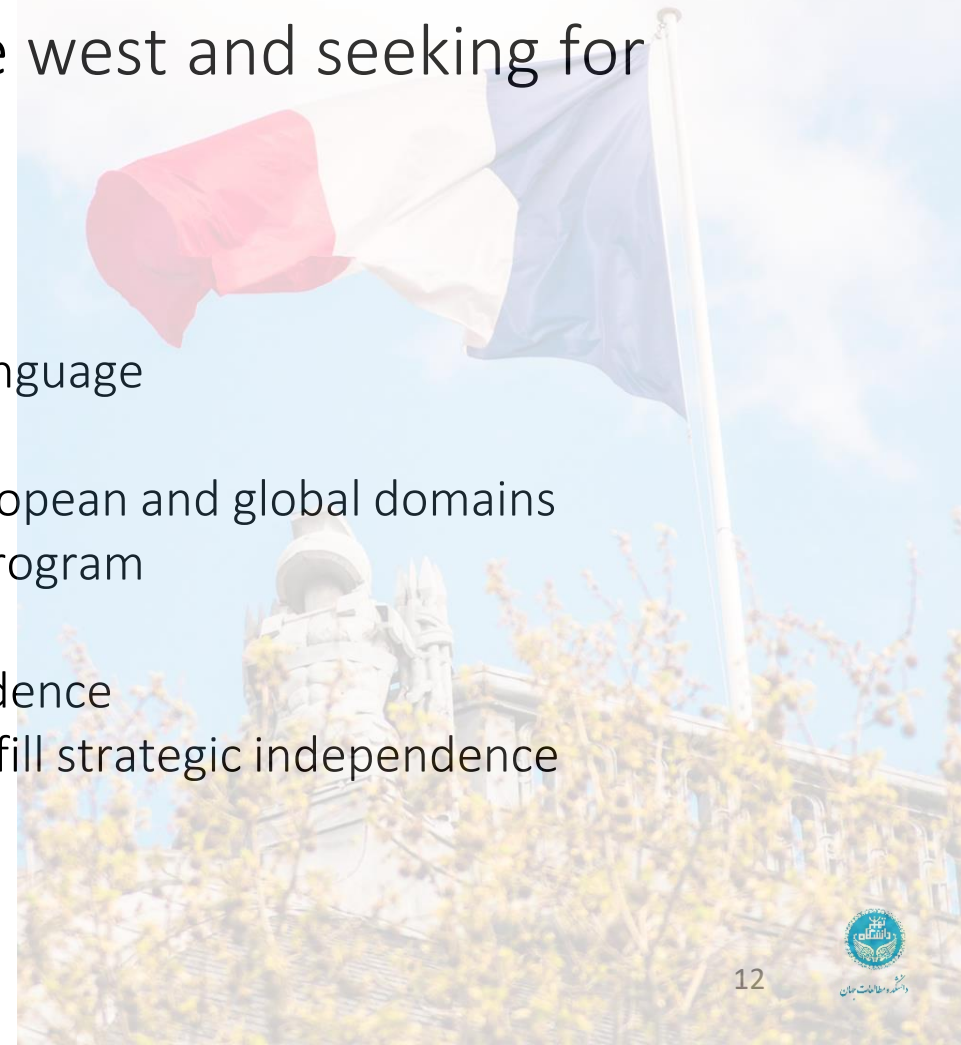
Worst bilateral relations in the 5th republic with Iran (since 1958)

Foreign policy principles

1. Freedom, equality, brotherhood
2. National governance and integrity (inseparable republic)
3. Laic republic
4. Democratic republic
5. Social republic

Driving forces in foreign policy

- Rejecting the American-oriented era for the west and seeking for a multi-lateral order (Gaullism)
- Strategic independence:
 1. France position in the international arena
 2. Keeping international network and investment in French language
 3. Insisting on its permanent membership in UNSC
 4. Expanding and renewal of the military forces in French, European and global domains
 5. Contribute in Global Strategy of European Union security program
 6. Implementing military act in European Union framework
 7. Following “influence diplomacy” to fulfill strategic independence
 8. French peace measures to expand French influence and fulfill strategic independence



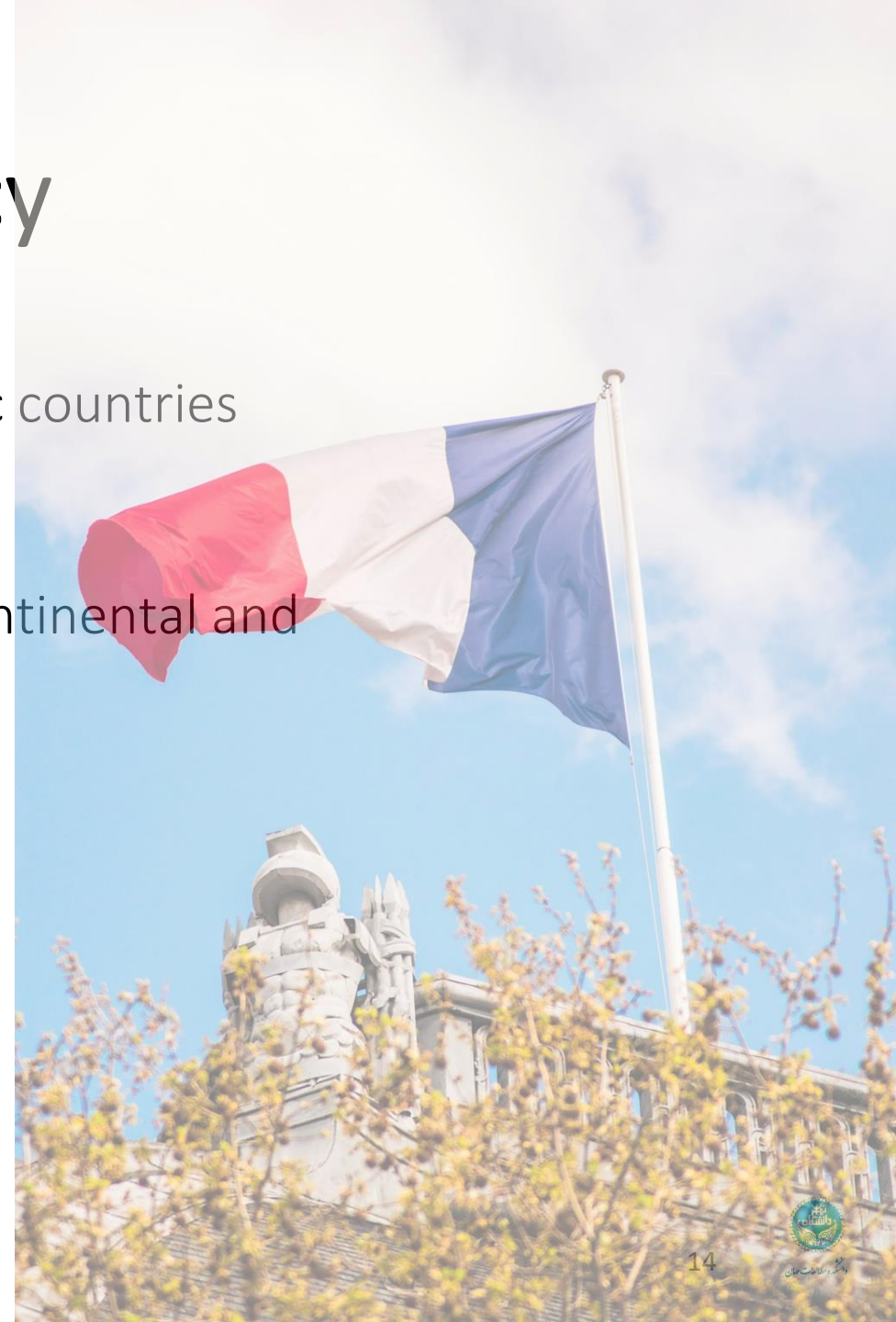
Driving forces in foreign policy
