Rational theory



Rationality and foreign policy decision making

Anarchic international system Influence of the structure

Bounded rationality: Herbert Simon

Calculations of national interest are self-evident

Maximization of utility by actors: the ultimate aim of foreign policy decision makers:

- Identify and prioritize foreign policy goals,
- Identify and select from the <u>means</u> available to it to fulfill its aims with the least cost,
- Trade off: different <u>possible</u> FP decisions and select one: <u>outcomes</u> matter.

Presumptions: undifferentiated decision-making body (unitary actor) & Universality

Robert Putnam

FP decision makers: two separate environments.

- **✓** Domestic concerns
- **✓** Different logics
- **✓** Information asymmetries

- Relation between domestic and foreign policy.
- Democratic peace... probable conflict between democracies and nondemocracies.



Challenging rational decision making: the role of psychology, cognition and personality

Distinction between operational (objective) and psychological environments (subjective)

Inaccurate: unitary entity of state.

Black box of FP decision making: actors, processes, structure and state.

Centrality of decision makers with their subjective biases.



Cognition

FP makers tend towards those policy choices that involve the fewest trade-offs, not necessarily the 'best' or 'optimal' policies
