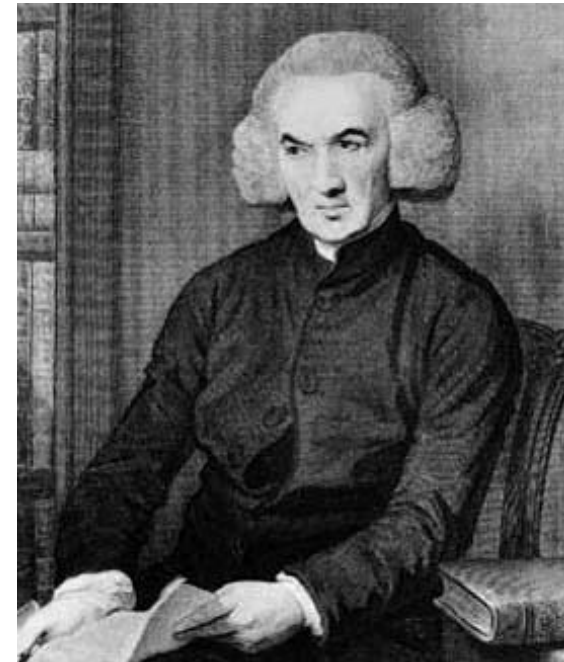

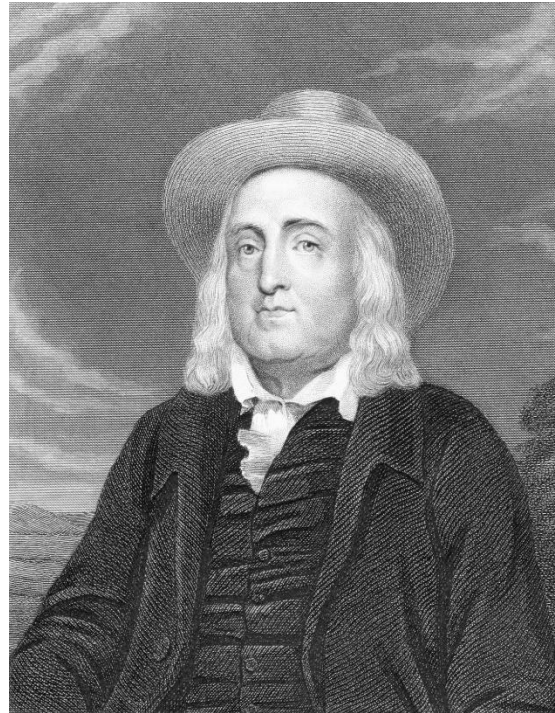
### Ancient philosophy:

- Roma: Came from Democritus (Pre-Socratic Greece): Will

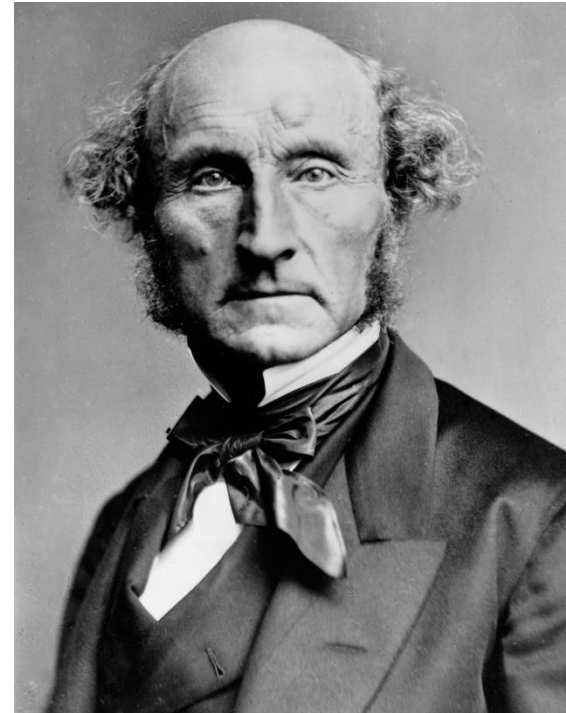
Socrates > Plato > Aristotle > Stoicism > Cambridge Platonics

1806 - 1873

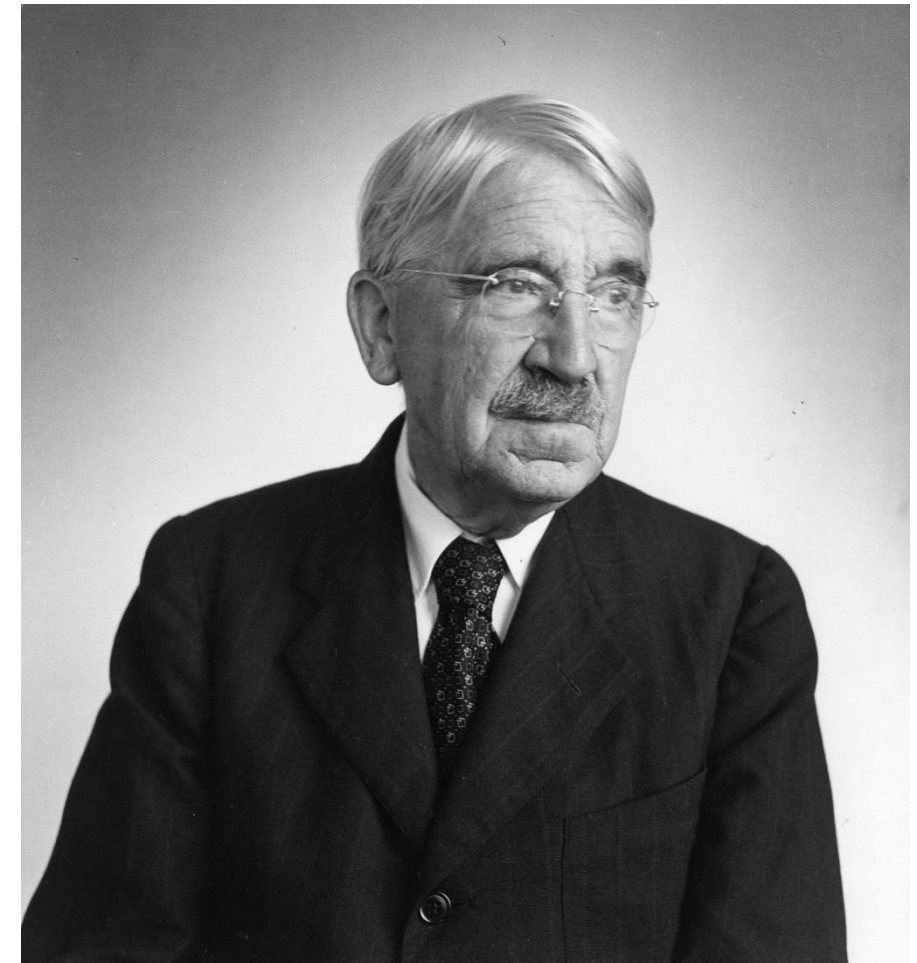
## American Pragmatism
