



National power polynomial



National power = $A_1(x,t) \times Military capabilities + <math>A_2(x,t) \times Economic$ cap.+ $A_3(x,t) \times National cohesion + A_4(x,t) \times geopolitical situation + <math>A_5(x,t) \times Technology + A_6(x,t)$ domestic and international legitimacy + $A_7(x,t) \times Technology + A_8(x,t) \times Technology + Technology + A_8(x,t) \times Technology + Technolog$




Different major sources of power



- United States: Military, technologic and economic
- Russia: Nuclear and Energy
- China: Trade and Technology
- Europe: Norm-setting:
 - Peace, human rights, environment,







- Establishment of the International Criminal Court (ICC)
- Opposition to the Iraq War (2003)
- Kyoto Protocol and Environmental Policies
- Opposition to the Death Penalty
- Promotion of Multilateralism Against U.S. Unilateralism
 - Example: Iran Nuclear Deal (JCPOA, 2015)
- Support for International Tribunals and Transitional Justice
